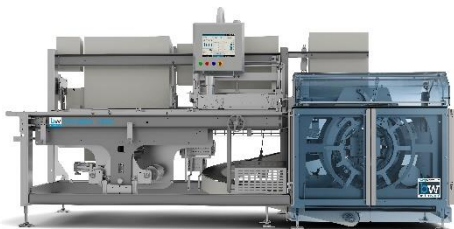

"It has a customizable RFID login, and the award-winning OpView™ HMI empowers operators through intuitive navigation, guided onboarding and step-by-step instructions — making it easy to onboard or train team members and optimize operation."
